COMPOSITION OF DELEGATION

The weight categories available for this training camp will be the following:

- Male: 48 kg, 51 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63,5 kg, 67 kg, 71 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 86 kg, 92 kg, +92kg.
- <u>Female</u>: 48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63kg, 66kg, 70kg, 75kg, 81kg, +81kg.

TRANSPORTATION

All the delegates will be welcomed at *International Airport Alicante* by the staff of the Organizing Committee to be transported to the Hotel.

The Organizing Committee will provide local transportation to all participants between the airport and the hotel and the competition venue free of charge. Each National Federation will organize and pay for the travel arrangements for their athletes and officials from their country to and from *International Airport Alicante* to their country.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

The participating delegation will be responsible for their travel expenses from/to respective country to/from the city of Alicante. Local transportation for Official Delegations will be covered by Organizer.

All travel expenses must be covered by participating teams.

FOR TRIPLE/ QUADRUPLE OCCUPANCY	EUR 70 per Person, per day,
(3/4 Persons per Room – Twin Beds)	all inclusive.
FOR DOUBLE OCCUPANCY	EUR 80 per Person, per day,
(2 Persons per Room – Twin Beds)	all inclusive.
FOR SINGLE OCCUPANCY	EUR 100 per Person, per day,
(1 Person per Room)	all inclusive.

All participating federations are required to pay of the total amount for their accommodation by bank transfer on <u>fifteen days before your arrival (October 15)</u>. To complete the registration to the Training Camp it's mandatory to pay the accommodation by bank transfer.

REQUIREMENTS

All Boxers must bring along with them:

- · Record Book with annual medicals duly completed and updated
- Current and valid Passport

INSURANCE

All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance

VISA

Those countries that need entry Visas for Spain must send us:

- a. List with names of Participants.
- b. Birth Dates.
- c. Passport Numbers.
- d. Copies of Passports.





Not later than September 30 and contact Embassy of Spain in their countries in advance or the nearest Consulate of Spain in neighboring countries. The organizing committee will provide all the necessary facilities for all the participating countries to enter into Spain. To ensure and speed up the visa application process, please remind to fill in the final Entry form carefully and send it to the organizing committee in due time. Based on this form the organizing committee will issue a formal visa support letter to facilitate the visa.

Please be informed that we'll not accept any visa support after this date.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR TEAM DELEGATIONS

All official members of Team Delegations, whether they are competitors or staff, international or local are obligated to:

- Present, on arrival, an individual COVID-19 medical certificates (PCR test made within 48 hours before arrival) with a negative result and certificate COVID vaccine complete.
- We inform you that <u>you can request a PCR test to return to your country</u>. We indicate that each of the tests has a price of € 100 (the Spanish public health does not carry them out), <u>if you are interested you have to send us the number of people and day to do the test (five days before your departure from Spain).</u>
- At the request of the Spanish Ministry of Health, we inform you that any person from countries of the European Union, associated Schengen area and Third Countries, have to fill out a record hosted on website of the Ministry of Health: https://www.mscbs.gob.es/profesionales/saludPublica/ccayes/alertasActual/nCov-China/spth.htm)
- Appoint a COVID-19 contact person from the official Team Delegation list, who will be present during the Tournament and will be in charge of any COVID-19 related issues for their Team Delegation.
- Wear a mask at all times during the Event, with exceptions of:
 - o boxers in training when it in not possible to wear it
 - o participants in respective hotel rooms, where it is the choice of participants
 - o participants during their meals only when seated at their dining table
- Observe social distancing at all times (1,5 m), except for boxers during their bouts and during warming up with their coach.
- Avoid entering hotel rooms of other participants under any circumstances.
- Avoid any contact with individuals who are not on the training camp as workers, other athletes...
- Submit to contactless temperature screening by the LOC and/or local health authorities at any time during the Training Camp
- Submit to COVID-19 testing at any time during the Training Camp on request of LOC COVID-19 Managers and/or local health authorities
- Follow all instructions of LOC COVID-19 Event Managers, including following isolation, quarantine, observation procedures and provision of detailed contact tracing in case of need
- Timely report all COVID-19 protocol violations during the Event to EUBC/LOC COVID-19 Managers.
