3.1. Participating Boxers

- Elite men boxers between the age of 19 and 40 according to their year of birth (born between 1984 - 2005) will be eligible to compete in the following categories: 46 kg - 48 kg, 51 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63.5 kg, 67 kg, 71 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 86 kg, 92 kg, 92+ kg.
- Elite women boxers between the age of 19 and 40 according to their year of birth (born between 1984 - 2005) will be eligible to compete in the following categories: 45 - 48 kg, 50 kg, 52 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63 kg, 66 kg, 70 kg, 75 kg, 81 kg, +81 kg.
- Reserve Boxers: If your National Federation is hesitating between 2 boxers, or simply wants to prevent any injury, please use the "Reserve boxer" function in the database. This function will allow you to register more than one boxer in the same category, and you will have the possibility to choose last minute which boxer will participate even after registration ended (only one boxer will be allowed to compete in each category).

3.3 Coaches and R&J s

-Each Boxer will be entitled to be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) Coaches. -Only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring. -All boxers must be accompanied by at least one IBA certified (1, 2 or 3 Star) coach at ringside during the bouts.

-All Coaches allowed to work in the Field of Play (FOP) must be IBA certified (1 to 3 Star). -If any team does not have a 1 Star coach, please raise this at the Technical Meeting so arrangements can be made with another team.

-Any coach of National Level, who has not certified through IBA, will not be allowed to enter the FOP.

- The Championships will be conducted according to current IBA Technical Rules and AOB Competition Rules.
- The Official Draw will be conducted by Swiss Timing system operated by ASBC officials through an electronic draw.
- The Scoring System will be based on a "Ten Point Must System".
 There will be five (5) Judges for each bout in accordance with electronic draw by IBA Scoring System.

10. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

10.1 All boxers must bring the following items to the sports entries check:

- Boxer's Passports
- Boxer's International Record Books
- Boxer's IBA Medical Certificate (Issued within the last 3 months)
- Declaration of Non Pregnancy certifying that the boxer is not pregnant.
- Anti-Doping consent forms signed by all of the boxers
- Video consent form
- Image rights consent form
- Uniform and robe (if applicable)
- Results of Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C and HIV tests, not older than 6 months. (Mandatory)

10.2 Each team Delegation must also bring the following:

- National Flag 1X1.5 m
- National Anthem on USB Drive/ CD in .mp3 format.

10.3 Boxer's Uniform:

- The vest and shorts/skirt can be in the Boxer's respective national colours or in red or blue colour according to the Boxer's respective corner allocation
- Women Boxers may wear a black sport form-fitting Hijab
- The belt line of any shorts/ skirts must be clearly indicated by a contrasting color and by using a 6.10cm wide elastic waistband (The belt line is an imaginary line from the navel to the top of the hips.)
- Bring Hair net/ bandanna (for boxers with long hair)

10.4 official boxing equipment
