

## REGULATIONS

**Of the International Boxing Tournament in memory of the Hero of the Soviet Union  
Duishenkul Shopokov and the 80th Anniversary of Victory in the Great Patriotic War**

### SECTION 1. Objectives and Tasks

- 1.1. Honoring the memory of Hero of the Soviet Union D. Shopokov.
- 1.2. Promoting boxing among the youth of the republic.
- 1.3. Selecting boxers for the national teams.
- 1.4. Developing international cooperation between national boxing federations.

### SECTION 2. Dates of the Tournament

- 2.1. The International Tournament will be held from April 28 to May 3, 2025, in Bishkek at the Sports Palace named after Kaba uulu Kozhomkul.
- 2.2. Arrival date is April 28, and departure date is May 4.
- 2.3. Teams arriving earlier or departing later than May 4 bear additional accommodation costs of USD 80 per day.
- 2.4. The Technical Delegate's meeting with team representatives and referees will be held on April 28 at 19:00, and the draw will take place at 20:00 at the Youth Center of the Sports Palace named after K. u. Kozhomkul.

### SECTION 3. Tournament Program

- 3.1. Weigh-ins for boxers will be conducted daily from 08:00 to 09:00 at the Sports Palace.
- 3.2. April 29: Opening ceremony at 13:00, fights start at 14:00.
- 3.3. From April 30 to May 3: Competitions start at 12:00.

### SECTION 4. Participants of the International Tournament

- 4.1. Men aged 19–40 are allowed to participate in the tournament (born between January 1<sup>st</sup> 1985 – December 31<sup>st</sup> 2006)
- 4.2. Boxers must present an identity passport, record book and MRI certificate (May 2024–April 2025) Without these documents, the athlete will not be admitted.
- 4.3. Referees serving the tournament must have a valid referee license confirming their status.
- 4.4. Each sports delegation is provided with boxing gloves.
